

PEACECHAPEL AT ST. MARK'S


Colorful, stained-glass windows portray

God's gift of creation, reminding visitors that humankind was created to live in peace with one another and in harmony with all of God's creation. Utilizing vivid, hand-blown glass, the windows have been designed and handcrafted by skilled Florida artisans specifically for The Peace Chapel. The chapel opens to a memorial garden, where guests can sit in the beauty of nature and enjoy solitude amidst the hustle and bustle of daily life.

A large stone altar reminds visitors that God is the rock of our salvation upon whom we place our faith and trust.

The chapel's floor is in the design of an ancient labyrinth, an enclosed, circular path that draws people of prayer into an intimate journey with God.

Through the journey on the labyrinth, a person is opened to the transforming grace of God's love as sorrows and fears, anxieties and angers are offered to God who promises to bring peace into the troubles of this life.


